Dear Sir,

The Twelfth Finance Commission has recommended that the scheme of Calamity Relief Fund (CRF) be continued in its present form with some minor changes. The size of the CRF for 2005-10 is kept at Rs. 21333.33 crore. [REDACTED] the definition of natural calamity is [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. The scheme of National Calamity Contingency Fund (NCCF) is also to be continued in the present form with core corpus of Rs. 500 crores.

2. Government of India has accepted the recommendations of the Finance Commission for 2005-10 and framed schemes for implementation of the recommendations of Calamity Relief Fund and National Calamity Contingency Fund in consultation with the Ministry of Home Affairs and Ministry of Agriculture.

3. I am enclosing a copy each of the schemes for the CRF and NCCF respectively, for further necessary action at your end.
