2. Quotation of a single price for the complete ERK Kit

The current BOQ provides separate entries for the 16 items forming part of the Emergency Responder Kit. Since the Department intends to procure the ERK as one complete and integrated kit, separate item-wise pricing may not be necessary.

Item-wise rates may also lead to differences in the allocation of common expenses such as packing, branding, transportation, inspection, consolidation and distribution. A consolidated price would provide a clearer basis for financial comparison and would avoid any ambiguity regarding the bidder's overall responsibility. We accordingly request that the BOQ be amended to contain a single entry on the following lines:

"Supply, Delivery, Commissioning and Related Services of one complete Emergency Responder Kit comprising all 16 items specified in the tender — Unit: Kit." The bidder may be allowed to quote one complete unit rate for the ERK Kit, inclusive of the cost of all 16 items, packing, branding, inspection, transportation, distribution, applicable taxes, duties and all incidental expenses required for successful completion of the supply. The suggested changes would make the delivery schedule more workable and the financial evaluation more transparent and consistent.
